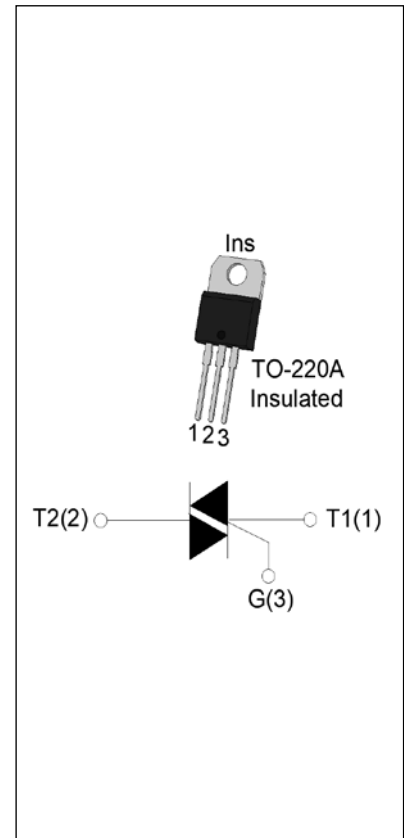


T1620H-8A 16A TRIAC

DESCRIPTION:

The T1620H-8A triac is suitable for general purpose AC switching. It can be used as an ON/OFF function in applications such as heating regulation, induction motor starting circuits, for phase control operation in light dimmers, motor speed controllers. Compared to traditional triacs, T1620H-8A provides a very high switching capability up to junction temperatures of 150°C. By using an internal ceramic pad, T1620H-8A provides a rated insulation voltage of 2500 VRMS, complying with UL standards (File ref: E252906). Package TO-220A is RoHS compliant.

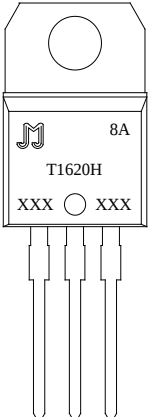

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FIG.1: Maximum power dissipation versus RMS on-state current

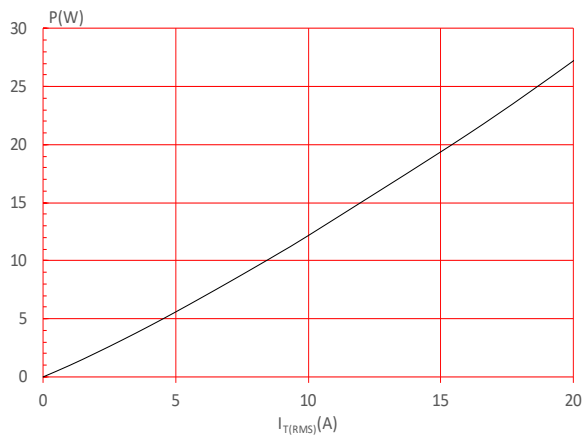


FIG.2: RMS on-state current versus case temperature

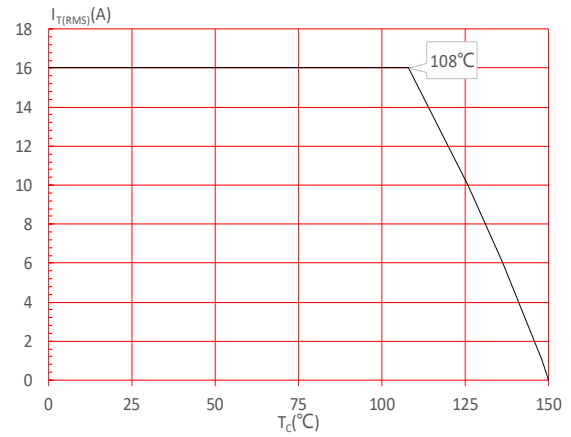


FIG.3: Surge peak on-state current versus number of cycles

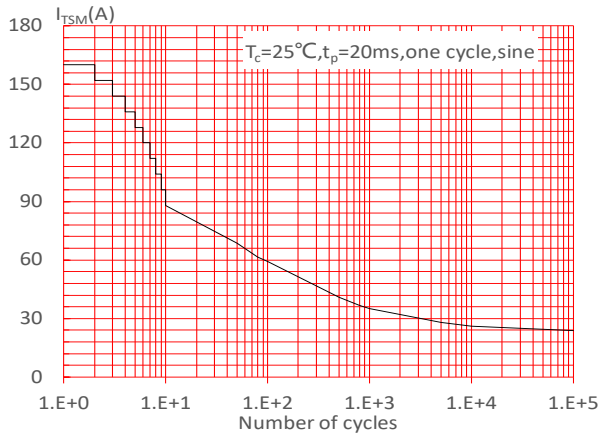


FIG.4: On-state characteristics

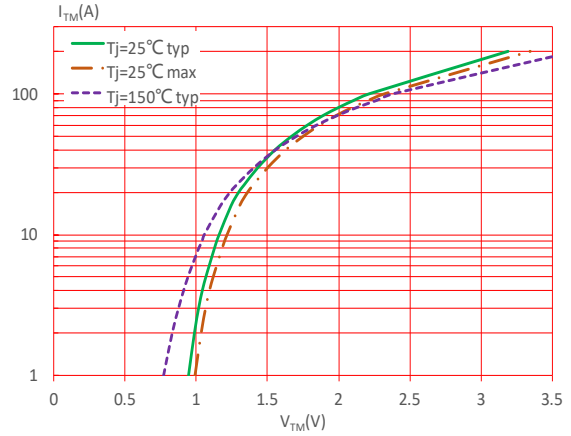


FIG.5: Non-repetitive surge peak on-state current for a sinusoidal pulse with width $t_p < 20ms$, and corresponding value of I^2t ($di/dt < 100A/\mu s$)

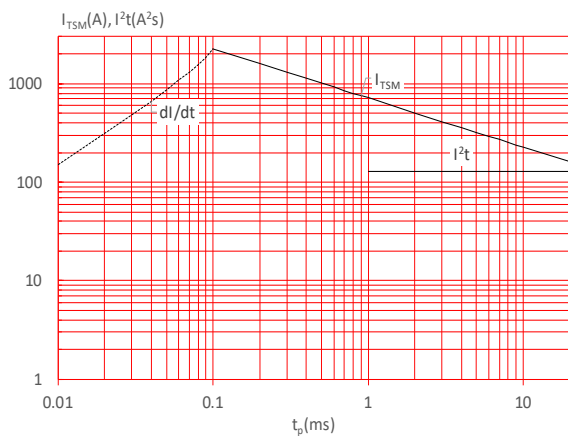


FIG.6: Relative variations of gate trigger current, holding current and latching current versus junction temperature

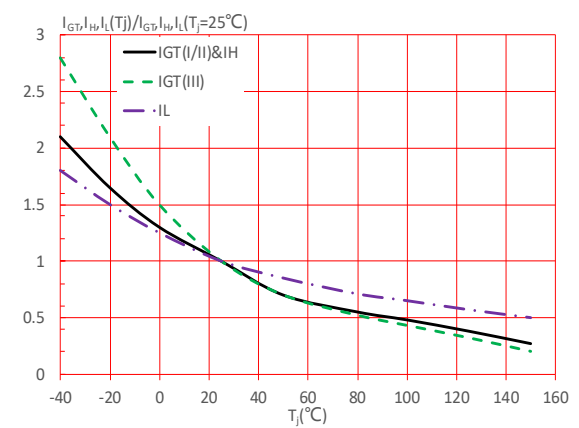
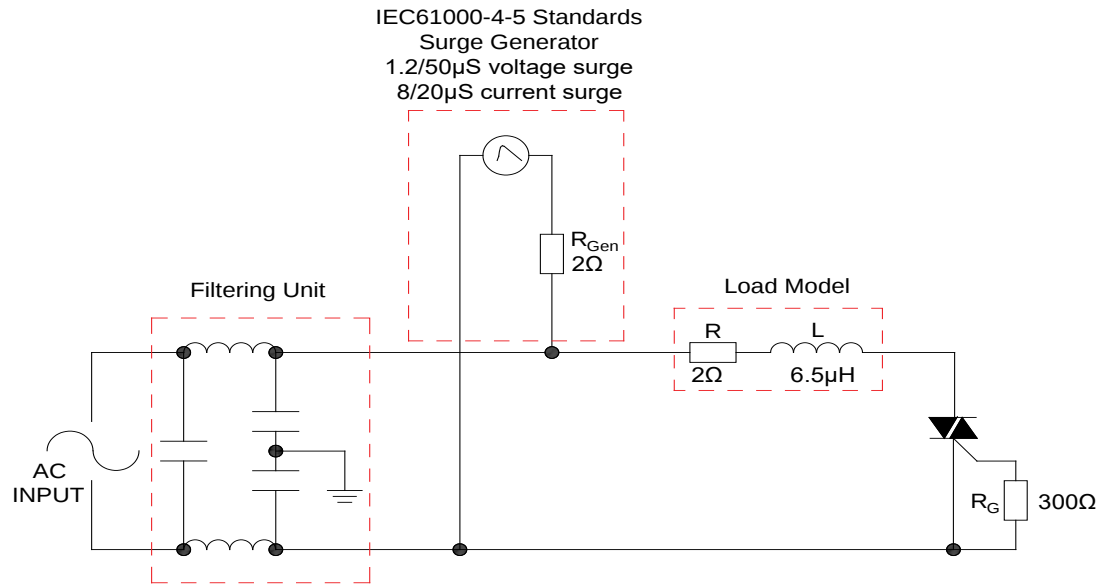


FIG.7: Test circuit for inductive and resistive loads to IEC-61000-4-5 standards

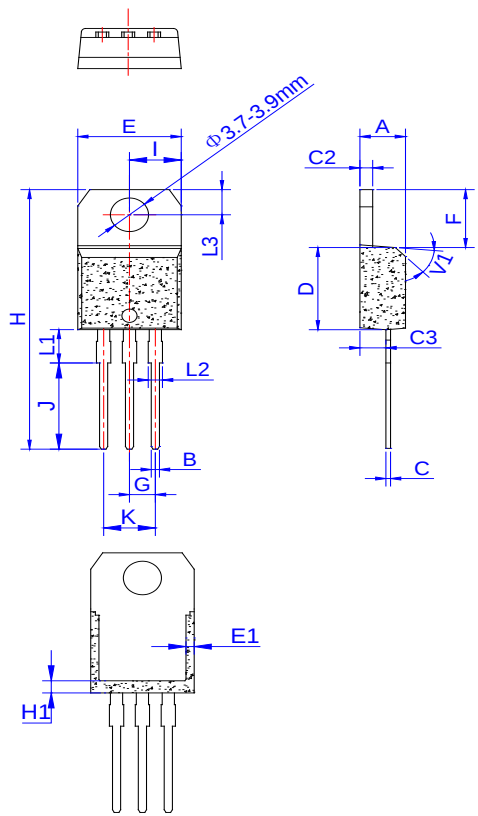

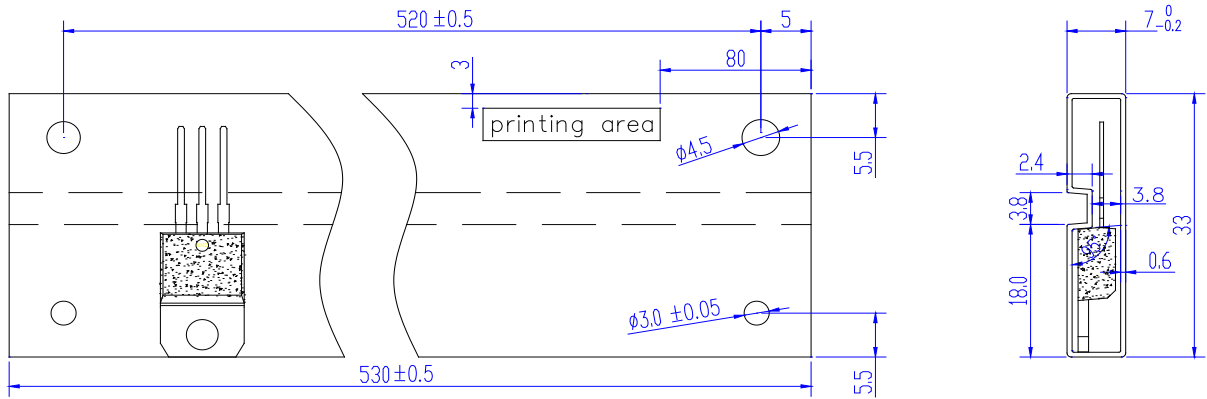
